

TOWN OF OLDS
BY-LAW 1269-83

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF OLDS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OLDS TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MINISTER OF SOCIAL SERVICES AND COMMUNITY HEALTH FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF FAMILY AND COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICE PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, (as amended), the Council may pass a By-Law authorizing the making of an agreement with the Minister of Social Services and Community Health for the performance of any matter or thing considered by Council and the Government of Alberta to be a benefit to both parties.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Preventive Social Services Act, R.S.A. and amendments, and the regulations passed thereunder, and Council of the Town of Olds, duly assembled, HEREBY ENACTS:

1. That the Council shall form a Family and Community Support Services Board consisting of seven members who shall serve for two year terms excepting the initial to create a staggered rotation. Membership shall consist of one Councillor and six members at large from the Olds community. Terms of membership shall be: three members - October 1983 to October 1984, and three members - October 1983 to October 1985, etc. The Town Councillor shall be appointed annually at the organizational meeting of Council. A member shall not serve more than two consecutive terms without a two year break.
 2. That is shall be the responsibility of the Board to recommend to Council on policy and programs related to the Family and Community Support Services guidelines. This shall include recommendations on funding for community groups related to the Family and Community Support Service guidelines.
 3. That the Council shall provide for the hiring of necessary support staff for an F.C.S.S. program.
 4. That the Council shall submit, as required, the reports and accounting forms that are required for funding.
 5. That the Board shall meet on dates to be set by agreement of members of the Board. Special meetings may be called by the chair, as required.
 6. That the Board shall elect annually a chairman, vice-chairman and secretary.
 7. That a quorum of the Board shall consist of any four members.
 8. That the passing of this By-Law hereby repeals By-Law 1081-76 and all amendments.
