This independent Foundation was created to distribute interest earned from the 1983 Alberta Summer Games Legacy. Applications must be received by **30 September** each year. Foundation Directors meet in October each year to consider applications. Funding is available for individuals or organizations that fit the criteria below:

- athletes or artists who require assistance toward elite performance where coaching, instruction or training beyond what is available in the community is needed. Emphasis is on the attainment of a level of performance or skill well-beyond the usual recreational or development levels.
- students pursuing a course of study in a field related to sport, recreation or culture. Bursaries are dispersed in June every year.
- coaches or instructors who are residents in Mountain View County and who have volunteered their time and expertise for the benefit of others. These grants are to assist the leader to develop knowledge and skill.
- sport and cultural organizations which are involved in exceptional and innovative programs.
