## Taxes Due June 30!

Property Taxes for 2011 are due at Town Office by 30 June 2011.

Regardless of method of payment or method of delivery, tax payments must be received at Town Office by 4:30 pm MST on Thursday, June 30, 2011 to avoid late penalties.

The 2011 combined Assessment & Taxation Notices for the Town of Olds were mailed on Thursday, May 12, 2011. Any property owner who did not receive his/her combined Assessment & Taxation Notice should contact Town Office for a copy prior to June 30, 2011.

The combined Assessment & Taxation Notice contains important information regarding assessment appeal procedures. Appeals must be postmarked on or before Tuesday, July 12, 2011, and must be accompanied by a completed form and the applicable fee.

Town of Olds Assessor Grant Clark will be at Town Office on June 23 & 24, 2011 to answer any Assessment questions. Consultation is by appointment or drop-in. To make an appointment, contact K. Greene at Town Office, 403.507.4807, or email [taxation@olds.ca](mailto:taxation@olds.ca).

If you prefer not to pay your taxes in one lump sum, you may sign up for the Monthly Tax Payment Plan (MTPP) for payment of property taxes for 2011 without penalty **if you apply by Friday, June 24, 2011** This is a free service. All you need to do is a) complete an application; b) provide us with a void cheque, and c) pay the outstanding monthly payments up to the date of application (January to June payments). Contact K.
