Recycle for a Good Cause

22 May 2009, Olds, Alberta – the Town of Olds is offering Olds residents the opportunity to safely get rid of unwanted personal documents while at the same time supporting a local charity!

On Saturday 20 June, the Town of Olds, in partnership with Paper Cuts Ltd., will set up a shredding station in the Olds Co-op parking lot, where residents can bring unwanted personal documents to be shredded and disposed of safely and securely. In return for this free service, citizens are asked to bring a food donation to support the Mountain View Food Bank.

Paper Cuts is generously donating its time and services for this project, and all shredded documents will be taken to the Paper Cuts warehouse in Red Deer, where they will be balled and shipped to recycling plants.
