

Town of Olds Toilet Replacement Program

Your big, old toilet is costing you a fortune! A toilet can waste thousands of litres of water every year, figuratively flushing your money down the drain. New six-litre toilets with proven technology can give the same results with less water, saving up to two-thirds water with every flush, and saving you up to \$100 per year in water and sewer charges.

The Toilet Replacement Program gives Olds citizens an opportunity to receive a toilet replacement Rebate for replacing old toilets with new water saving toilets. Applicants may be eligible for a toilet replacement Rebate by installing water saving six-litre, 4.5-litre or three-litre / six-litre dual flush toilets. Rebates range from \$50 to up to \$100 per toilet.

Water saving toilets can cost as little as \$150. A list of eligible toilets is available at www.olds.ca/toilet.pdf or visit Town Office for a list. Review the performance information and choose a toilet best suited to your home or office.

How it Works

STEP 1 - Determine your Eligibility

Eligible Applicants

- Current Town of Olds Water & Wastewater Utility customer
- Utility Account in good standing
- Property built before 1 January 2007 (**PLEASE NOTE: homes built and renovations completed AFTER 1 January 2007 are NOT eligible for rebates under the Town of Olds Water Conservation Bylaw.**)
- Have a 13-litre or 20-litre toilet to replace

STEP 2 - Purchase a new water-saving toilet

Eligible Toilets

Six-litre (6L), 4.5-litre or three-litre / six-litre (3L/6L) dual flush toilets must be on the Town of Olds acceptable toilet list (on the Water & Wastewater page of our website or available at Town Office). Sales receipts must be included with your application. Maximum of five toilet replacement Rebates per Utility account.

STEP 3 - Old Toilet Verification

Remove all of the inside parts of the old toilet. Complete an application form at Town Office so that staff may verify the toilet's eligibility for a Rebate. Staff will give you a verification receipt. Take the receipt and your old toilet to the Public Works Shop at 4825 51 Street between 9 am and 3 pm Monday to Friday, where staff there will inspect and dispose of the toilet for you. Limit of five toilets per Utility account.

STEP 4 - Send in your Application

To Receive your Rebate - Send in:

- Completed application form
- Original sales receipt for new toilet (keep a copy for your records)
- Verification receipt for old toilet

Program Starts in Spring Each Year

Toilet replacement Rebates are processed on a first-come, first-processed basis. Incomplete applications will be returned and applicants must then resubmit them. Retroactive applications may also be accepted dated January 1, 2007 onward.

One application form must be completed for each toilet replacement Rebate. Maximum of five toilet replacement Rebates per Utility account. Rebate amounts (GST is non-refundable):

- 6L toilet replacement - up to \$50
- 4.5L toilet replacement - up to \$75
- 3L/6L toilet replacement - up to \$100
