## TOWN OF OLDS BYLAW NO. 2024-47

Being A bylaw of the Town of Olds, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the revised statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto, to provide for the amendment of the Land Use Bylaw No. 01-23.

**WHEREAS** the *Municipal Government Act*, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, permit a Council by bylaw to amend the Land Use Bylaw, and

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Olds deems it necessary and expedient to amend the Land Use Bylaw No. 01-23,

**AND WHEREAS** the requirements of the *Municipal Government Act* RSA 2000, Chapter M-26 regarding the advertising of this Bylaw and public hearing have been complied with;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Olds in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

## **BYLAW TITLE:**

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Land Use Amendment Bylaw No. 2024-47.
- 2. Bylaw No. 01-23, being the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw, is hereby amended.

The following change to Land Use Bylaw 01-23 is proposed:

## **DELETE:**

Section 1.9.10(a) publishing notice at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in at least one newspaper or other publication circulating in the community, and

## ADD:

Section 1.9.10(a) publishing a notice in accordance with the Town of Olds Advertising Bylaw for a minimum of fourteen (14) days, and

3. This Bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.

Read for the first time on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 2024. Read a second time on the 9th day of December 2024. Read a third and final time on the 9th day of December 2024.
