Olds College suspending 3 programs due to decrease in international student enrolment Brendan Ellis Feb 27, 2025

Olds College is suspending intake for three programs this fall due to a decrease in revenue from international student admissions.

The school is projecting a \$5.1 million loss of tuition revenue for its 2025-26 budget. It also said it has seen a decrease in operational grant funding from the provincial government over the past few years.
