REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 2026-10

Bylaw No. 2026-10 proposes to amend the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw by rezoning a portion of NE 1/4 Sec. 6, Twp. 33, Rge. 1, W5M from Future Urban (FUD) to Traditional Neighbourhood District (RTD). A public hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held on **Monday, May 25, 2026, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Olds Municipal Centre.
