Notice of Development

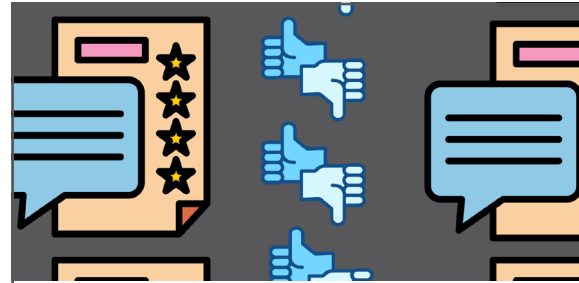

Branch Dump Still Open

The seasonal Residential Yard Waste Area opened on May 2, 2026 at the Olds Municipal Centre (3501-70 Avenue). Residents can access the space using the north entrance (follow the signs).

The Branch Dump is still open, but the Grass Clippings Area is closed until October.

This program provides residents of Olds with a convenient, environmentally responsible way to dispose of branches and yard waste.

Branch Dump (Early May until the end of October):

Open to Olds residents only.

Hours of Operation:

- Tuesdays & Thursdays – 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- Saturdays – 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- Open May 2 to end of October (weather permitting)

Accepted Items:

- Branches, small trees or shrubs - 6" diameter or smaller (about the width of two hockey pucks side by side)
- Dry leaves (minimal grass or other organics allowed)

Please avoid bringing large volumes of wet material or mixed waste, as these affect end-of-season burning.
