## TOWN OF OLDS BYLAW NO. 2023-10

A bylaw of the Town of Olds, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the revised statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto, to provide for the amendment of the Land Use Bylaw No. 01-23

**WHEREAS** Section 640(1) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statues of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, provides that every municipality must pass a land use bylaw; and

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statues of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, permit a Council by bylaw to amend the Land Use Bylaw; and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Olds deems it necessary and expedient to amend Land Use Bylaw No. 01-23

## NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Olds duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1) That Schedule D, Section 4.0 Signs Not Requiring a Development Permit is amended by adding:
  - (d) election signs
- 2) That Schedule D, Section 17.0 Other Signs is replaced with the following:
- 17.0 Election Signs
  - (a) Election signs may be installed on public or private property.
  - (b) Signs shall have a maximum area of 0.5m<sup>2</sup> when installed on public property.
  - (c) There is no maximum area for signs installed on private property.
  - (d) Signs shall not interfere with the safety and convenience of pedestrians, cyclists, motorists, or other users of public sidewalks, streets, boulevards, or property.
  - (e) Signs may only be installed in road rights-of-way within the Town between noon on the close of nomination day until 72 hours after election day.
  - (f) Notwithstanding Subsection 17.0(a), signs shall not be placed anywhere on property where a voting station is located. This includes fences located on or bordering the property, or property adjacent to any voting station.
- 18.0 Other Signs

The Development Authority may approve other signs subject to the General Provisions of Section 5.0 of Schedule D. [2011-01]

3) This Bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.
