Rain Barrel & Compost Bin Rebate Programs

Rainwater collection and home composting offer substantial environmental benefits.




Notice of Public Hearing

REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 2025-11

Bylaw No. 2025-11 proposes an amendment to the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw to redesignate Lot 13, Block 1, Plan 1710892 and Lot 4, Block 1, Plan 1511656, also identified as 6102 and 6402 48 Avenue, from Direct Control 7 (DC7) to Light Industrial (I1). The subject lands are shown in the sketch below. The bylaw also introduces a new defined use of 'Data Centre' to the Land Use Bylaw. This proposed redesignation aligns with both the Municipal Development Plan and the Southeast Industrial Area Structure Plan, which identify this as industrial property in their land use concept maps.

A copy of the proposed bylaw and related documents may be seen during regular hours (8:30 AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday) at the Town of Olds Office building, 4512 46 Street. A copy of the bylaw is also available on the Town website at <https://www.olds.ca/PublicHearings>.

A Public Hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held **Monday, June 9, 2025, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Town Office. The style of the hearing will be informal and persons wishing to speak will be requested to state their name and address for the record upon being recognized by the Chair. Council will hear submissions made in person or by the agent from any person who claims to be affected by the proposed bylaw. Any person wishing to submit written comments may do so by sending them to the Town of Olds Planning and Development department, at the address below. Comments received prior to **4:00 PM on June 3, 2025** will be included in the staff report to Council and comments received after will be read at the public hearing. Persons may make oral presentations at the Council meeting, regardless of whether or not they have provided written comments.
