REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 2026-29

Bylaw No. 2026-29 proposes broad amendments to the Cornerstone Area Structure Plan. Changes include an updated Land Use Concept with more mixed-use and medium- to high-density residential development, as well as expanding the area of the plan to include some land south of Highway 27 that is not currently part of an Area Structure Plan. A public hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held on **Tuesday, October 13, 2026, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Olds Municipal Centre.

A copy of the proposed bylaw and related documents may be seen during regular hours (8:30 AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday) at the Town of Olds Municipal Centre building, 3501 70 Avenue. The draft bylaws are also available on the Town website.

Preparing Your Trees for Winter

A little fall care can help your trees stay healthy through winter and reduce the risk of damage.

- **Water Well:** Give trees a deep watering during dry fall weather, especially young or newly planted trees, until the ground freezes.
- **Renew Mulch:** Add a layer of mulch around the root zone to conserve moisture and protect roots from temperature changes. Keep mulch away from the trunk and avoid mulch volcanoes.
- **Skip Late Fertilization:** Avoid late-season, high-nitrogen fertilizer, which can encourage new growth before winter.
- **Check for Hazards:** Inspect for dead, broken or weak branches, especially those over buildings, driveways and walkways. Remove hazards before heavy snow arrives.

A few simple steps now can help your trees weather the winter and come back strong in spring.
