

Branch Dump Still Open!

The Residential Yard Waste Drop Off area is located at the Operations Centre on the west end of town. This program provides residents with a convenient and environmentally responsible way to dispose of yard waste.

While the Grass Clippings area is closed until October, the Branch Dump remains open.

Branch Dump (May to October):

Open to Olds residents only.

Hours of Operation:

- Tuesdays & Thursdays – 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- Saturdays – 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- Open May 1 to end of October (weather permitting)

Accepted Items:

- Small trees and shrubs (6" diameter or smaller)
- Branches
- Dry leaves (minimal grass or other organics allowed)

Please avoid bringing large volumes of wet material or mixed waste, as these affect end-of-season burning.

Secondary Suites

Until July 10, 2025 the Town of Olds will make it easier for homeowners to legalize their existing secondary suites. During this period, a simplified application process and reduced fees will be in effect to encourage registration. After July 10, 2025 more robust enforcement measures, including fines and legal actions, shall be implemented.

The specific incentives that have been put in place are:

- Waiving of development fees for existing secondary suites.
- Relaxation of parking requirements for existing secondary suites.
- Relaxation of square footage requirements for existing secondary suites.
- Accelerated application process.
