TOWN OF OLDS BYLAW NO. 2025-19

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, permit a Council by bylaw to amend the Land Use Bylaw; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Olds deems it necessary and expedient to amend the Business License Bylaw 2020-09.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Olds in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

BYLAW TITLE: This Bylaw may be cited as the Business License Bylaw Amendment 2025-19.

GENERAL RULES AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Bylaw 2020-09, being the Town of Olds Business License Bylaw, is hereby amended as follows:

1. By replacing Section 6.6 with:

A Business License is only valid when it has been issued via the Town of Olds "PSD Citywide" online portal.

2. By replacing Section 15.1 with:

Every Business License issued under this Bylaw shall be made out and delivered to the Licensee who shall be able to produce the license for inspection purposes when required.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.
