

## Olds Sportsplex Temporary Closure Notice

Please be advised that the Olds Sportsplex will be temporarily closed beginning June 8 for a major electrical upgrade to the facility's power system.

This work is required to improve power capacity and reliability, helping support facility equipment and reduce the risk of future outages. Due to the scope of the project and safety requirements, the building must remain fully closed during construction.

The Sportsplex is expected to reopen later this summer.

While the facility is closed, teams and users may wish to explore other available recreation spaces in nearby communities to maintain programming during this period.

REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW  
NO. 2026-13

**Bylaw No. 2026-13** proposes to amend the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw by rezoning a portion of Lot 7 and all of Lot 8, Block 35, Plan 2652S from Traditional Neighbourhood District (RTD) to Mixed Use Node (MUN). A public hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held on **Monday, June 8, 2026, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Olds Municipal Centre.

Pursuant to Section 311(1) of the Municipal Government Act, the 2026 Combined Assessment and Taxation Notices for the Town of Olds were mailed or emailed on **May 15, 2026**. Property owners who do not receive their notice within a reasonable time are asked to contact the Olds Municipal Centre to obtain a copy.

The notice contains important information regarding assessment appeal procedures. Assessment complaints must be submitted on or before **July 22, 2026**, and must include the applicable fee noted on the notice. The fee will be refunded if the appeal is successful.
