REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 2026-07

Bylaw No. 2026-07 proposes an amendment to the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw to redesignate NW-4-33-1-W5 from Future Urban (FUD) to Light Industrial (ILD). The subject lands are shown in the image online. The proposed amendment aligns with both the Municipal Development Plan and Northeast Area Structure Plan. A public hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held on **Monday, February 9, 2026, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Olds Municipal Centre.

REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 2026-06

Bylaws No. 2026-06 proposes amendments to the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw relating to regulations that pertain to accessory buildings and multi-dwelling residential developments. The amendments are intended mainly to improve clarity and remove ambiguity in the regulations. A public hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held on **Monday, February 23, 2026, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Olds Municipal Centre.
