REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 2026-13

Bylaw No. 2026-13 proposes to amend the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw by rezoning a portion of Lot 7 and all of Lot 8, Block 35, Plan 2652S from Traditional Neighbourhood District (RTD) to Mixed Use Node (MUN). A public hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held on **Monday, June 8, 2026, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Olds Municipal Centre.
