

TOWN OF OLDS
BYLAW NO. 2016-30
A BYLAW TO AMEND THE LAND USE BYLAW

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF OLDS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS Chapter M-26.1, Part 17, Division 5, Section 634 of the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended, for the purpose of providing a framework for subsequent subdivision and development of an area of land, a Council may by bylaw adopt an area structure plan; and

WHEREAS Chapter M-26.1, Part 5, Division 9, Section 191 of the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended, allows the Council of a municipality the power to pass a bylaw, amend, and/or repeal a bylaw; and

WHEREAS the Uptowne Olds Area Redevelopment Plan has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Part 17 of the *Municipal Government Act*, as amended, and adopted as Bylaw 02-05; and

WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to amend the Town of Olds Uptowne Area Redevelopment Plan adopted under Bylaw 2013-08;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF OLDS IN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Land Use Concept Map of the Uptowne Olds Area Redevelopment Plan, Bylaw 2013-08, be amended reflect the concept shown on attached Schedule 'A'.
2. Citation: This bylaw may be cited as "Town of Olds Bylaw 2016-30."
3. This Bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.

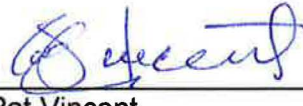
