### A chance for Olds residents to say what town's priorities should be

Residents are urged to provide feedback on what they believe priorities should be for things like service levels, funding priorities and infrastructure planning, via the municipality's annual budget engagement survey, now live on the town's website.

#### Man sentenced to three years in major drug and weapons seizure in Olds

Eric Donald Becker, 36, was sentenced in Calgary Court of Justice on June 23, 2025, after being convicted on charges of possession for the purpose of trafficking, and possession of a prohibited/restricted firearm.

#### Olds RCMP seize \$60,000 in illegal cigarettes
