REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 2026-06

Bylaw No. 2026-06 proposes amendments to the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw relating to regulations that pertain to accessory buildings and multi-dwelling residential developments. The amendments are intended mainly to improve clarity and remove ambiguity in the regulations. A public hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held on **Monday, February 23, 2026, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Olds Municipal Centre.
