

## **TOWN OF OLDS BYLAW NO. 2026-15**

**WHEREAS** Section 640(1) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, and amendments thereto, provides that every municipality must pass a land use bylaw; and

**WHEREAS** the *Municipal Government Act*, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, permit a Council by bylaw to amend the Land Use Bylaw; and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Olds deems it necessary and expedient to amend the Land Use Bylaw No. 2025-14.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Town of Olds in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

**BYLAW TITLE:** This Bylaw may be cited as the Land Use Amending Bylaw 2026-15.

### **GENERAL RULES AND SPECIAL PROVISIONS**

Bylaw 2025-14, being the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw, is hereby amended as follows:

1. That the Land Use District Map, being Schedule A of the Land Use Bylaw 2025-14, be amended to change the designation of Lot 20, Block 3, Plan 1812464 from Traditional Neighbourhood District (RTD) to Mixed Use Node District (MUN) as shown on the attached Schedule A.

### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.

### **READINGS**

Read for a first time on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May 2026.
