Branch Dump Still Open

The seasonal Residential Yard Waste Area is located at the Olds Municipal Centre (3501-70 Avenue). Residents can access the space using the north entrance (follow the signs).

The Branch Dump is still open, but the Grass Clippings Area is now closed until October.

This program provides residents of Olds with a convenient, environmentally responsible way to dispose of branches and yard waste.

Branch Dump (Early May until the end of October):

Open to Olds residents only.

Hours of Operation:

- Tuesdays & Thursdays – 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- Saturdays – 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- Open May 2 to end of October (weather permitting)

Accepted Items:

- Branches, small trees or shrubs - 6" diameter or smaller (about the width of two hockey pucks side by side)
- Dry leaves (minimal grass or other organics allowed)

Please avoid bringing large volumes of wet material or mixed waste, as these affect end-of-season burning.

REGARDING PROPOSED BYLAW NO. 2026-21

Bylaw No. 2026-21 proposes to amend the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw by rezoning Lot 6, Block 13, Plan 2396HE, also known as 5337 49 Avenue, from Traditional Neighbourhood District (RTD) to Mixed Use Centre (MUC). A public hearing regarding the proposed bylaw will be held on **Monday, August 24, 2026, at 1:00 PM** in the Council Chambers at the Olds Municipal Centre.
