TOWN OF OLDS BYLAW NO. 2022-24

A bylaw of the Town of Olds, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the revised statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto, to provide for the amendment of the East Olds Area Redevelopment Plan Bylaw No. 2014-15

WHEREAS Section 634 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, allows Council of a Municipality to adopt an Area Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS Section 191 of the *Municipal Government Act*, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, provides the Municipality with the authority to amend a bylaw; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Olds deems it necessary and expedient to amend the East Olds Area Redevelopment Plan Bylaw No. 2014-15;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Olds duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. That the East Olds Area Redevelopment Plan Bylaw No. 2014-15, be amended by changing the land use assigned to Lot 1, Block 13, Plan 2396HE on Map 4: Future Land Use from "R3 –Medium Density Residential" to "CN Commercial Neighbourhood" as shown on the attached Schedule A.
- 2. This Bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.
