Updates at the Sportsplex

Beginning September 21, 2026, the Town of Olds will be moving from cash payments at the Olds Sportsplex to online registration and payment for all Drop-In Sticks & Pucks sessions.

Registration and payment available to be completed online before attending.

Cash payments will no longer be accepted at the facility for Drop-In Sticks & Pucks after October 31.

Spaces may be limited, so we encourage you to register in advance.

Please have your registration confirmation available when you arrive.

This new system will make it easier to register, pay, and keep track of available spaces for each session.

Helmet, hockey gloves, stick, neck guard required, full equipment recommended. Participants age 12 and under require adult supervision.

Branch Dump Still Open

The seasonal Residential Yard Waste Area is located at the Olds Municipal Centre (3501-70 Avenue). Residents can access the space using the north entrance (follow the signs).

The Branch Dump is still open, but the Grass Clippings Area is now closed but will reopen in October.

This program provides residents of Olds with a convenient, environmentally responsible way to dispose of branches and yard waste.

Branch Dump (Early May until the end of October):

Open to Olds residents only.

Hours of Operation:

- Tuesdays & Thursdays – 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- Saturdays – 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- Open May 2 to end of October (weather permitting)

Accepted Items:

- Branches, small trees or shrubs - 6" diameter or smaller (about the width of two hockey pucks side by side)
- Dry leaves (minimal grass or other organics allowed)

Please avoid bringing large volumes of wet material or mixed waste, as these affect end-of-season burning.
