## 2025 Municipal General Election

### Voter Identification Requirements

Section 53 of the *Local Authorities Election Act* and Section 100 of the *Election Act* establish the general basic requirements for Verification of the person's identity and current residence.

**Any person attending a voting station for the purpose of voting must be allowed to vote if:**

- the person is at least 18 years old;
- is a Canadian citizen;
- resides in Alberta and the person's place of residence is located in the local jurisdiction on election day;



**Residents of the Town of Olds are required to provide identification to prove their identity and current address, in order to vote.**

A resident can vote if their name is on the Permanent Electors Register and they produce one piece of identification issued by a Canadian government, whether federal, provincial, or local, or an agency of that government, that contains a photograph of the person.

Or, residents not on the Permanent Electors Register can vote if they fill out the prescribed Form 13 and produce one piece of identification issued by a Canadian government, whether federal, provincial, or local, or an agency of that government, that contains a photograph of the person, or present two pieces of identification authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer that establishes the person's name and at least one of which establishes a voter's current address.
