



Conditions of Use for the Olds Aquatic Centre

1. Payment in full is due at the time of making the booking unless you are an approved organization.
2. The Olds Aquatic Centre requires seven (7) days notice for cancellation or change to the rental contract.
Please refer to the Olds Aquatic Centre Refund policy for details.
3. 90 days written notice for a cancellation of rental when the OAC has cancelled regular programming for your rental- (ie all day Swim Meet)
4. Changes to the rental contract will only be accepted in writing (ie email). These changes must be sent in a minimum of seven (7) days before rental date.
5. Any changes made to the rental contract must be done by the person who originally made the reservation or by an approved designated person.
6. You are responsible for your group/ and or party's actions and conduct during your reservation. Your current and future reservation requests may be cancelled if the following should occur:
 - Fighting
 - Unseemly conduct
 - Health violations ie: (spitting, smoking, drinking alcohol etc)
 - Abusive behavior towards staff
 - Mistreatment and/or misuse of equipment
7. You are responsible for ensuring garbage and recycling are put away. OAC Staff will sweep, mop and put tables and chairs away.
8. Alcoholic beverage are strictly prohibited.
9. Damage and or/destruction of property will result in repair and/or replacement fees billed directly to you.
10. In all circumstances, the Town of Olds retains full authority for final approval and denial of facility rental reservation requests.

All Olds Aquatic Centre rules apply to your group during your rental:

- Lifeguards may use their own discretion and may intervene on any situation they deem potentially unsafe. Guests must respect the requests of lifeguards at all times.
- All children under the age of 9 must be accompanied in the water by a responsible adult. This adult **MUST** stay within arms reach of the child at all times.
- The ratio of adult to children under 9 is 1:3
- Anyone wanting to swim in the deep end without a PFD/Lifejacket may be asked to do a swim test which entails: Jumping into the deep end and swimming to the shallow end without touching the side or bottom.
- All guests need to take a shower before entering the pool or hot tub.
- Please do not bring outside shoes, gum, food or drink in change rooms or on deck.
- Pushing, shoving, dunking, roughhousing and foul language will not be tolerated.
- Diving must occur in the deep end only.
- Please do not run in the facility.

Waterslide

- Feet first seated or lying on back
- It is recommended that children be 48 inches to ride the slide alone. Small children may ride with a parent or guardian.
- No stopping or standing up on the slide.
- Please exit the trough immediately at the bottom.
- Please do not take toys on the slide (rings, balls, etc.).
- Children may wear a properly fitted lifejacket/PFD on the slide with all buckles and straps done up properly to prevent scratching the slide.

Hot Tub

- Max of 17 people in the Hot Tub at any one time.
- Please do not take toys or lifejackets in the hot tub.
- Please do not submerge your head in the hot tub.
- No splashing or jumping into the hot tub.
- Maximum stay in the hot tub is 15 minutes- you will be asked to take a break after this time.

Diving Board

- Only one person at a time on board.
- Please take only one bounce.
- Please do not dive or jump towards the sides of the pool.
- Please keep clear of area under and around diving board.
- Back dives or back flips are not permitted anywhere in the pool.
