

**TOWN OF OLDS  
BYLAW NO. 2006-22**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OLDS RESPECTING THE OLDS AND DISTRICT  
LIBRARY BOARD**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Library was established, by Bylaw 1244-82 on June 28, 1982, and

**WHEREAS**, Bylaw 1244-82 did not specify the legal name, of the Municipal Library, within the Bylaw, and

**WHEREAS**, Council has deemed it right and proper to determine the composition of the Library Board and method of appointments thereto,

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Olds, in the Province of Alberta, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) The Olds and District Municipal Library is hereby established and shall be managed, regulated and controlled by the Town of Olds Library Board.
- 2) The Town of Olds Library Board shall consist of the following voting membership:
  - i) A minimum of One (1) and a maximum of Two (2) representatives of Olds Town Council
  - ii) One representative of Mountain View County Council
  - ii) Factoring the number of Town Council appointees, between Three (3) and Eight (8) members at large who can be residents of the Town of Olds or Mountain View County as long as the majority are residents of the Town of Olds.
- 3) The policies of the Town of Olds Library Board shall be governed by Parts 1 and 5 of the Libraries Act, Chapter L-11 Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 and amendments and regulations pertaining thereto.
- 4) This Bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading.
- 5) Bylaw No. 1244-82 is hereby repealed.
- 6) Citation: This bylaw may be cited as "Olds and District Municipal Library Board Bylaw".
