
**“NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING”**  
**April 28, 2022**

On April 28<sup>th</sup>, people across Canada will recognize a Day of Mourning for all workers who have been killed, injured or disabled at their place of work.

The Town of Olds and Workers Compensation Board for Alberta recognizes workers in Alberta who have died as a result of workplace injury or illness. In Alberta, 178 workers died in 2021 as a result of workplace injury or illness. Over the past years, Olds has recognized a Day of Mourning to remember those losses.

In remembrance and as a tribute to the workers killed or injured on the job, Olds Town Council, Olds Alberta, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, April 28<sup>th</sup>, as “National Day of Mourning” in the Town of Olds, to mark the day the Town of Olds flags will be lowered to half-mast.
