Metal Cans & Foil Trays (rinsed and free of contaminates)

#### Follow these 4 steps:

- 1. Remove lids and caps from bottles and cans.
- Empty and rinse containers. Labels can be left on.
- 3. Place recyclables loose in the recycling bin. Do not put them in bags.
- 4. Flatten cardboard boxes.

#### Do not include:

- · Bagged recyclables
- · Plastic bags or film
- Disposable coffee cups
- Glass jars
- Scrap metals
- Electronics & batteries
- Plastics without 1-7 🗱 symbol
- · Plasticized, waxed and laminated material · Household hazardous waste
- · Mirrors, ceramics, window glass or Pyrex®
