PROCLAMATION

“NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING”

April 28, 2020

On April 28th, people across Canada will recognize a Day of Mourning for all workers who have been killed, injured or disabled at their place of work.

The Town of Olds and Workers Compensation Board for Alberta recognizes workers in Alberta who have died as a result of workplace injury or illness. In Alberta, 165 workers died in 2019 as a result of workplace injury or illness. Over the past years, Olds has recognized a Day of Mourning to remember those losses.

In remembrance and as a tribute to the workers killed or injured on the job, Olds Town Council, Olds Alberta, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, April 28th, as “National Day of Mourning” in the Town of Olds, to mark the day the Town of Olds flags will be lowered to half-mast.
