POLICY STATEMENT

Council will set the policy for the removal of snow and control of ice from streets, Lanes, Trails and Sidewalks as designated by specific maps.

PURPOSE

To set out priorities for winter road maintenance in the Town of Olds. To enhance safe traffic and pedestrian movement and provide satisfactory driving surfaces where ever reasonably possible. To establish guidelines for the removal of snow from Trails and Sidewalks adjoining and accessing property owned by the Town of Olds insofar as the Town's resources will allow.

DEFINITIONS

In this Snow Removal Policy:

'Designate' means someone appointed by the Director of Operations.

'Lanes' means a narrow road providing access to the rear of buildings and parcels of land.

'Trails and Sidewalks' means a municipal walkway or footpath that provides access to a Town facility or Town property to be used for the accommodation of pedestrians which is located outside of a street.

SCOPE

This policies applies to streets, Lanes, Trails and Sidewalks located within the Town of Olds boundary.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Director of Operations, or Designate, shall be responsible for the implementation of this policy.
