Monthly Tax Payment Plan (MTPP)

January is the best time of year to enroll in the Monthly Tax Payment Plan (MTPP), because your tax account is at zero and you do not have to make any "catch up" payments. For example, if you join at the beginning of June, you would have to make the first five months payments up front in one lump sum and then your first automatic monthly payment would start June 15.

The MTPP gives taxpayers the flexibility to make automatic monthly payments for taxes rather than a single and annual payment. If you find it difficult to make one lump sum payment when taxes are due in June, the MTPP might help.

Monthly installments break the annual payments into 12 smaller payments making budgeting easier. Participants are NOT subject to late penalties or services fees – this is a free service to Olds Taxpayers.

Utility Rate Changes

An increase to the water rates of \$0.11 per cubic meter from \$2.99/m³ to \$3.10/m³ for all customers.

An increase to the wastewater rates of \$.11 per cubic meter from \$4.61/m³ to \$4.72/m³ for residential customers.

An increase to the wastewater rates of \$.11 per cubic meter from \$5.07/m³ to \$5.18/m³ for non-residential customers.

The change in utility rates will be reflected for services on customer's January 1 - 31, 2023 bills that will be mailed by February 10, 2023.

Rate increases are directly related to increases for the purchase and discharge of water/wastewater received from the commission.

2023 Business Licences

Business Licence renewals are due February 28, 2023

2023 business licence renewal invoices will be mailed out early January. Business licence renewals are due February 28, 2023. Payment can be made:

- Online: olds.ca/virtual-city-hall
- Online banking (choose "Town of Olds AR" as payee and use your customer ID as the account number)
- In person at the Town of Olds Administration Building.

2023 Animal Licences

Animal Licence renewals are due February 28, 2023.

All dogs and cats 3 months of age or older MUST have a licence. All animal owners are encouraged to spay and neuter their pets. If your animal is found and has a collar with a licence attached this helps us reunite you with your lost pet. As per the Town of Olds Rates Bylaw 2022-27 effective January 1, 2023, animal licence fees will be as follows:

- Cat or Dog - neutered/spayed \$25.00
- Cat or dog - Intact \$35.00

Please note: rates increase by \$15.00 after February 28, 2023. You can now pay your animal licence through your online banking. Use "Town of Olds AR" as the payee and your customer ID as the account number.

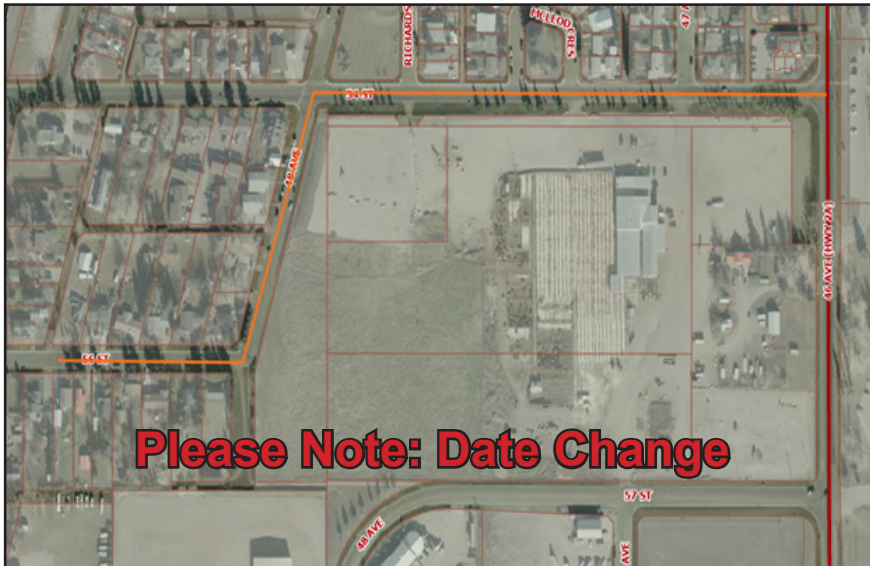

4. Temporary Closing of Roadways

4.1 In any case where, by reason of any emergency or any other special circumstances, it is the opinion of the Chief Administrative Officer or his authorized designate that is desirable and in the public interest to do so, the Chief Administrative Officer or his designate may:

- (a) Temporarily close within the Town, any roadway, sidewalk, boulevard, or public parking lot, in whole or in part to traffic.

Notice of Development

Any person who deems they may be affected by the issuance of these development permits may appeal to the Regional Subdivision & Development Appeal Board of the Town of Olds within twenty-one (21) days of the application approval. Appeal applications are to be filed with the Secretary of the Regional Subdivision & Development Appeal Board at Parkland Community Planning Services, and must include your name, address and phone number.
