The Town is creating a new long-term plan for lands on the northeast part of the Town. This plan will support new industrial and commercial growth, and will:

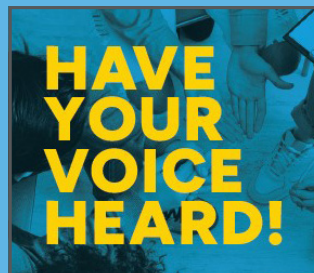
- Set a long-term plan for growth in the area

Community Grass Bins: Upcoming Changes

Due to increasing costs, contamination, and misuse, the Community Grass Bins program is no longer viable.

After listening to community feedback from the 2022 and 2023 Budget Survey, the Town of Olds has increased frequency of residential black, blue and green bin services to provide residents a more robust, effective and practical waste management solution. Residential green bins pickup occurs weekly between April 1 and November 1 and includes a mid-winter pick up in January.
