- Respect neighbouring property owners

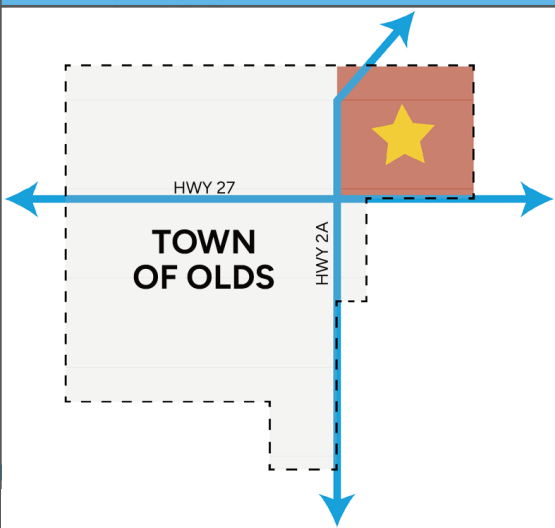

Green bins pickup now occurs weekly between April 1 and November 1 and includes a mid-winter pickup in January.
