



FCSS FUNDING PERIOD NOW OPEN

Eligibility Requirements

All applicants must be a registered non-profit that serves Town of Olds residents. Individuals or for-profit groups and businesses cannot apply for funding.

Funding cannot be used for:

- recreation;
- public health transportation;
- direct assistance, including money, food, clothing or shelter, to sustain an individual or family;
- rehabilitation; or
- duplication of services provided by other government agencies.

Application Requirements

Applications must fall within one or more of the following criteria:

- help people develop independence, strengthen coping skills and become more resistant to crisis;
- help people to develop an awareness of social needs;
- help people develop interpersonal and group skills which enhance constructive relationships among people;
- help people and communities to assume responsibility for decisions and actions which affect them;
- promote, encourage and facilitate the involvement of volunteers.
- provide supports that help sustain people as active participants in the community.

Applications close November 30, 2023.
