

TOWN OF OLDS BYLAW 2018-41

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OLDS, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the revised statutes of Alberta 2000 and amendments thereto, to provide for the amendment of the Land Use Bylaw 01-23,

WHEREAS the *Municipal Government Act*, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, permit a Council by bylaw to amend the Land Use Bylaw,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Olds deems it necessary and expedient to amend the Land Use Bylaw 01-23,

AND WHEREAS the requirements of the *Municipal Government Act* RSA 2000, Chapter M-26 regarding the advertising of this Bylaw and public hearing have been complied with;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF OLDS IN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Land Use Amending Bylaw 2018-41.
2. Bylaw 01-23, being the Town of Olds Land Use Bylaw, is hereby amended as follows:
 - a) In Schedule B: Supplementary Regulations. 12 Cannabis: Regulations for Cannabis Uses **delete**:

12(1) Cannabis Retail Sales

The following regulations apply for the use of cannabis retail sales:

- a) Any cannabis retail sales store shall not be located less than **150 metres** from:
 - i. a public health care facility,
 - ii. a building containing a school,
 - iii. a boundary of a parcel of land that is designated as school reserve,
 - iv. another cannabis retail sales use,
 - v. a municipal library, or
 - vi. an indoor community recreation centre.

Any cannabis retail sales store shall not be located less than **100 metres** from:

- i. a public park, playground or outdoor recreational facility.

- b) In Schedule B: Supplementary Regulations. 12 Cannabis: Regulations for Cannabis Uses **add**:

12(1) Cannabis Retail Sales

The following regulations apply for the use of cannabis retail sales:

- a) Any cannabis retail sales store shall not be located less than **100 metres** from:
 - i. a public health care facility,
 - ii. a building containing a school,
 - iii. a boundary of a parcel of land that is designated as school reserve under the *Municipal Government Act*,
 - iv. another cannabis retail sales use,
 - v. a municipal library,
 - vi. an indoor community recreation centre, or
 - vii. a public park, playground or outdoor recreational facility



3. This Bylaw comes into force on the date it is passed.

Read a third and final time on the 10th day of December, 2018
