- curb/gutter cleanup and boulevard sweeping;
- cleaning shop and Town vehicles;
- equipment operation; and

- cemetery internments.
- signage repair.
- asphalt patching.
- garbage removal.

Qualifications: Valid Class 5 Drivers' License, and a willingness to learn. Preference may be given to applicants that have a vail Class 3 Drivers' License and/or related equipment experience. Due to the physical nature of these positions, candidates must be in good physical condition. Students or recent graduates of horticulture, landscaping, civil construction, or engineering related programs are encouraged to apply.
