Municipal Election 2021 - October 18, 2021

Town of Olds - Municipal Election:

A Municipal Election is held every four years in accordance with the provincial Municipal Government Act (MGA). Citizens in Olds vote for a Mayor and six (6) Councillors who are responsible for establishing corporate policy and setting strategic priorities for the Town of Olds.

Province of Alberta - Senate Election:

In conjunction with the Municipal election, the Province of Alberta issued a proclamation to hold a Senate Election, which will be held in conjunction with Municipal Elections. Province of Alberta - Referendum:

Orders in Council were issued August 9, 2021 for two referendum questions to be voted on during Municipal Elections. Both questions allow for a YES or NO vote.

- 1. Should Section 36(2) of the Constitution Act, 1982-Parliament and the Government of Canada's commitment to the principle of making equalization payments, be removed from the constitution?**
- 2. Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?**

Voter Identification Requirements:

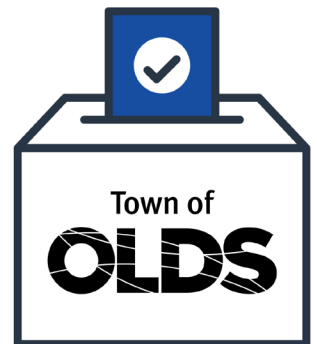
In order to vote, you must produce identification issued by a Canadian Government, (federal, provincial, or local), that contains a photograph of the elector and his or her name and current address, or:

1. Bank/Credit card statement or personal cheque.
2. Correspondence issued by a school, college or university.
3. Government cheque or cheque stub.
4. Income/property tax assessment notice.
5. Insurance policy or coverage card.
6. Letter from public curator, public guardian or public trustee.
7. One of the following, issued by the responsible authority of a shelter or soup kitchen: Attestation of residence, letter of stay, admission form, or statement of benefits.
8. Pension Plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation.
9. Residential lease or mortgage statement.
10. Statement of government benefits, e.g. employment insurance, old-age security social assistance, disability support or child tax benefit.
11. Utility bill, e.g. telephone, public utilities commission, television, hydro, gas, or water.
12. Vehicle ownership or insurance certificate.

In addition to the above forms of identification an elector voting in an institution may provide the following forms of identification:

Correspondence issued by a hospital, auxiliary hospital, nursing home or seniors or special care accommodation facility attesting residency, such as a letter of stay, admission form, or patient profile sheet that includes the name and address of the person.

Electronic Voting:

The Town of Olds uses an electronic voting system. Voters will receive 2 separate ballots at the polling station as follows:

1. Ballot for Town of Olds Municipal Election - Ballot #1 is to Vote for one (1) Mayor and **up to six** (6) Councillors.
2. Province of Alberta Senate Election - Ballot #2 is to vote for **up to three** (3) Senate seats; and answer two (2) Province of Alberta Referendum Questions.

Please mark your ballot with an "x" or by filling in the circle completely.

For Mayor, select **up to 1** choice on the ballot.

For Councillor, select **up to 6** choices on the ballot.
